

## JMST Manuscript Submission Guidelines

Manuscripts should follow the below guidelines prior to being submitted into our peer-reviewed process. Manuscripts must not be under simultaneous consideration by any other journal, during the peer-review process.	
Journal Aim:	To disseminate current and practical tennis-related medical and scientific information to all our stakeholders (players, coaches, health care professionals, scientists, and tennis organizations) in order to optimize the health and performance of tennis players worldwide.
Patient Consent:	Manuscripts including human subjects must include whether written consent was obtained from the local Ethics Committee or Institutional Review Board.
Types of Manuscripts accepted:	Original research, literature reviews, case studies, abstract review, systemic review/meta-analysis
Manuscript Formats:	Manuscript pages should be typed double-spaces with the pages and line numbers. Indicate the title of the manuscript within this file. Generally, manuscripts should be 5,000 words or less (not including references, figures, and tables). Manuscripts should be submitted as a word document (.docx) and use times new roman 12-point font with one-inch margins. All tables should be included within the main manuscript document and placed within the appropriate spot within the text. Tables taken from other published work must receive permission for use from the publisher.
Abstract:	An abstract should summarize the content of the article in fewer than 300 words. Please include the abstract in the manuscript file with the following headings: Background, Purpose, Methods, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion  *Abstract Reviews do not need to include an abstract
Figure Submission:	Figures for manuscripts must be uploaded as a PDF at 300 dpi for black and white figures and color figures at 600 dpi. Figures taken from other published work must receive permission for use from the publisher.
References:	References should be in AMA Style format
Author bios:	At the end of the manuscript please include a brief author(s) bio
Author headshots:	All headshots for all authors should be uploaded as a sperate PDF file. 300 dpi for black and white headshots and color headshots at 600 dpi.
Title Page:	A word document separate from the main manuscript file should include the title of the manuscript, author(s) information and affiliation, and corresponding author information and affiliation including email
